7. Article of wood using saw, drill and sander with applied finish
8. Article of wood using at least 2 methods of router, chisel countersunk screws or lathe
9. Article of wood containing use of miter or end lap joint
10. Any article of wood turned or lathed (Bowls)
11. Wood lawn ornament - painted
